

RULES OF FIRE

1. The shoot will be run according to NRSA rules except where otherwise determined by the range committee.
2. Course of fire consists of Rifle:- 4 sighters and 60 scoring cards, 1 shot per card. Pistol:- comprises of 4 sighters and 30 scoring cards, 2 shots per card.
3. Each course will last a maximum of 1hr 45mins, including your sighting shots.
4. There are unlimited shots on your sighting cards. Once you have commenced your competition cards you must not return to the sighter. Dry firing is allowed at any time during your course of fire.
5. The line on the floor denotes the correct shooting distance and your feet must be behind this line at all times.
6. No part of your body is allowed to touch the table whilst you are shooting.
7. Competitors must not talk on the range whilst shooting is in progress.
8. Competitors with cylinders are required to leave the range quietly to change them.
9. In the event of a competitor finishing the detail early, he/she may leave the range, but **NO EQUIPMENT** must be packed away until all the competitors have finished their details and the **ALL CLEAR** has been announced.
10. When you have finished shooting please hand your shot cards to the scorers **ASAP**.
11. Competitors are reminded of range safety. Infringement will result in a warning from the range officer; any subsequent violation may result in expulsion from the range and disqualification from the competition.
12. In the event of a gun malfunction please notify the range officer. A maximum of 15 minutes may be added to your detail time for the correction of the fault.
13. In the event of a range malfunction the range officer will call a cease fire, competitors will be informed of how long it took to fix the problem and the time will automatically be added to the end of the detail.
14. Any competitor scoring well above their declared averages may be subject to reclassification at the discretion of the range committee.
15. All mobile phones to be switched off or placed on silent ring.
16. If required warnings will be issued as 10, 5 and 1 minute remaining in detail.
